## REPORT OF THE PARTICIPATION OF ENG STUDIES AT THE NATIONAL CONGRESS OF BIOMEDICAL SCIENCES - KOPAONIK

It is with great pleasure that I report of the activity of the students in English at the Student National Congress of Biomedical Science in Kopaonik, held from 24.04. until 28.04.2023.

With 26 researches enrolled in the book of Abstracts, 39 students participating as authors and coauthors in the researching and writing, we believe we reach a new record in the participation of our students to the research field in our Studies.

As Student Board Vice-President, I had the pleasure to informally lead our delegations of students at the Congress, in this I was helped by my younger colleagues; Ivana Malbaša, Student Board secretary and Tara Kneževič, SB delegate for CSNIRS.

The MFUB ENG Studies was among the most numerous delegations, counting almost 40 students, of all years of Studies except second year. I consider that also in this field, we reach a new record in terms of participation. ENG studies recorded two section-winners: Maja Vejapi, Emergency medicine with anesthesiology and Thomas Klifopoulos, General subjects.

Taking in account the above-mentioned datas, I consider that our last 2-3 years of efforts to raise the consciousness and awareness of the possibility to write a student research paper, especially in clinical years, is showing finally some very positive results. With previous year 15 students delegation, this year 40 students delegation, we are reaching the interesting result that almost one student every 8-10 in our Studies writes a research paper. I encourage my younger colleagues to continue this way, while I kindly ask our Coordination Board and prof.dr. Mihaljević to continue to support our colleagues. This way, the opening of the student section of the website could help even more as infos about research papers can be founded there too.

Moreover, I remark the great opportunity of this Congress to strengthen the bound among our students. I notice that in all section in which we had a ENG Studies presentation, we had at least 3 colleagues as support. Furthermore, it is a great opportunity also for meeting younger/older colleagues in a still very academic environment. Not to forget the opportunity for our students to get in touch and meet with other researches from Serbian Studies as well as from other Faculties and Cities too.

It is considering all the above and the fact that we didn't register any accidents involving ENG students that I conclude that our participation at the Student National Congress of Biomedical Science was successful and positive.
