EVALUATION AND FORMATION OF FINAL MARK

PRE-EXAM ACTIVITIES (maximal 30 points)

Attendance 0 – 6 points

- Regular attendance of lectures until March 13th, 2020 carries 0 to 6 points:
 - 6 points: attendance at 6 lectures
 - 5 points: attendance at 5 lectures
 - 4 points: attendance at 4 lectures
 - 3 points: attendance at 3 lectures
 - 2 points: attendance at 2 lectures
 - 1 point: attendance at 1 lectures
 - 0 points: attendance 0 lectures

Inclass activities (during practicals and seminars) are estimated from **0 to 4 points** by teachers who conducted practicals and seminars.

- 3) Multiple answer test consisting of 6 questions with 5 offered answers, out of which 2 are correct 0-6 points
- 4) Test with clinical vignettes -0-4 points
- 5) Essay -0-10 points
