

THE ANNEX OF FINAL EXAM GRADING POLICY IN NEUROLOGY FOR THE SCHOOLYEAR 2020&21

As students in the VIII semester of schoolyear 2020&21 had no live practicals and colloquia due to epidemiological reasons, the final exam will consist of:

1. **Pre-exam points – 0 – 10 points** (0-6 attendance of seminars and lectures, 0-4 activity on practicals).
2. **Single best answer test consisting of 70 questions with 4 offered answers, out of which one is correct – 0-70 points.**
IMPORTANT: To pass the test and continue with exam, a student is obliged to have at least 36 correct answers.
3. **Multiple answer test consisting of 6 questions with 5 offered answers, out of which 2 are correct - 0-6 points.**
4. **Test with clinical vignettes – 0 – 4 points**
5. **Essay – systematized report of a disease given by a student, 0-10 points.**
