


Karton

+ Karton literally means cardboard or sheet

- + This is where the instructors will record your attendance, participation, and scores.
- + The Karton is usually held onto by the instructors in pre-clinical courses, while for clinicals the Karton will either be kept by the department or each individual student.
- + The Karton in ENG Studies is provided by the Administrative Office to the course directors at the beginning of the year.
- + Regarding the photo, at the beginning of each year, make sure you have a passportsized photograph of yourself ready for each of your Kartons. If there is no photo on your Karton, the document will not be recognized, and you will not be able to attend the colloquia or exam of that class.
