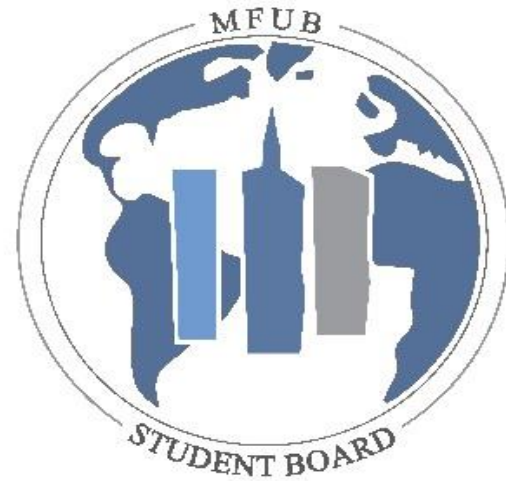

Introduction

- In this presentation, we would go through some of the most common «bills» you have to pay if you live in an apartment in BG.
- Costs and type of bills may differ from case to case. For example, television service may be provided by SBB or by MTS-Telekom or even a third operator. Depending from the case, your bill will look and cost differently.
- Bills can be paid at every Posta Office, including the one in the Head Building (groundfloor). Posta usually offer the smallest provision.

EPS - Electricity



- EPS – Elektro Privreda Srbija is the only electricity provider in Serbia therefore if you have to pay bills, EPS would be for sure one of them.
- EPS bills need to be paid regularly otherwise they turn off (cut) the electricity in your apartment.
- By EPS, you can pay in advance for the next month and get a small discount. This is the reason why it is up to the single person to write the amount of money he/she want to pay in a single monthly payment. This option is highly advice if you are going on holiday for a long period.
- Note: electricity in Serbia is among the cheapest in Europe.


Infostan



- Infostan is among the most common bills in BG.
- Infostan covers and provides the following:
 - Heating during winter (but which is paid during the entire year);
 - Water
 - Other «ecological» taxes.
- By paying before the 15 day of the month, you can a discount on the next month bill, if I'm not wrong the discount is around 5-10%.

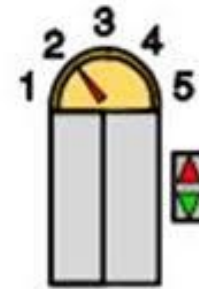
There are several major Internet providers in Serbia, and the choice often depends on the type of access you need or whether you want your Internet bundled with other services, such as telephone or cable TV. Some of the major Internet providers are:

- [Telekom Srbija](#) - offers both ADSL Internet and mobile Internet
- [SBB](#) - Serbia Broadband - offers cable Internet access
- [Telenor](#) - offers mobile Internet access
- [Orion](#) - offers WiFi Internet packages
- [Vip](#) - offers mobile Internet access
- [Verat](#) - offers ADSL and WiFi Internet access
- [Beotel](#) - offers ADSL Internet access

There is also a growing number of WiFi hotspots around the cities, especially in cafes, restaurants and parks.

Building maintenance

- According to a recent change of the Serbian Law, every apartment's owner need to pay a certain amount for the building maintenance.
- Under building maintenance, there is the cleaning of stairs, elevator, etc.
