Mini-symposium:

Every year in April there is an exposition of student research papers (Mini-Symposium) which usually anticipate the National Congress of students of Biomedical Science in Serbia, Congress which has an International character, participation.

Mini-symposium represents the final selection and evaluation of oral presentation by a commission composed of eminent professors of the Medical Faculty in Belgrade. The selection and evaluation have the goal of better prepare the students to the National Congress.

The right to participate to the Mini-Symposium is obtained by students, authors of research papers who have received two positive reviews from the reviser (professors of the MFUB) and verified by the Commission for Student Research Paper.

Authors with two positive reviews are obliged to present their work at the Mini-symposium, otherwise the MFUB wouldn't cover the cost of the participation to the National Congress.

The right time and section-orders in the Mini-Symposium will be announced on time on the CSNIRS media channels.

FAQs:

- **When and where is the Mini-symposium organized?**

In March (usually at the end) or in April (at the beginning) in the spaces of the Head building.

- **What are the conditions to present my work at the Mini-Symposium?**

Two positive reviews from anonymous revisers, members of the teaching staff of the MFUB, who need to satisfy the same requirements like the mentors.

- **Does the co-author can present the research paper instead of the author?**

Yes, it can. However, in the Records, the author would be mentioned first.
