Join CSNIRS:

• What does CSNIRS mean?

CSNIRS stand for Centar Sa Naucni Iztrasivacki Rad Studenta, Centre for Research Works Students.

• What is CNIRS?

CNIRS is volunteer organization, sub-section of the Student Parlament (Serbian Studies n.t.) which operate with the aims of promotion of Research as well as the organization of the Student Research activity. Furthermore, CSNIRS participate and organize events whose goal is the general promotion of Science in the population.

• Who is eligible to become a CSNIRS member?

Any regular student of Faculty of Medicine, University of Belgrade who is attending third or higher semester (i.e. \geq 2nd year), with average grade of 8.5 or higher.

- How to become a CSNIRS member? To become a CSNIRS member, student should apply for an interview, which is organized every October/November.
- Where is the CSNIRS office?

In the Head Building basement, the same office is shared together with Medical Youth Journal.
