

## CALL

FOR THE ENROLLMENT OF THE STUDENTS IN THE FIRST YEAR OF STUDIES AT THE  
FACULTY OF MEDICINE BELGRADE IN THE SCHOOL YEAR 2025/26

Integrated academic studies of Medicine in English language (360 ECTS)

### **Students' quota**

The Faculty of Medicine enrolls:

- for obtaining the title of doctor of medicine (integrated academic studies lasting 6 years, 360 ECTS) - studies in English, 80 self-financing students, citizens of the Republic of Serbia and foreign citizens:
- for obtaining the title of doctor of medicine (integrated academic studies lasting 6 years, 360 ECTS) - studies in English, 50 self-financing students, according to special international agreements

### **Specific requirements for enrollment**

An applicant who has previously completed four-year secondary education and is medically capable to study medicine can enroll in the first year of medical studies,

Necessary secondary education for medical studies includes general high school, secondary medical school, veterinary school and other schools in the field of health sciences.

Knowledge of the English language is a requirement for studied in English.

A prerequisite for enrolling in a study program conducted in English is proof of knowledge of the English language at an upper intermediate level of competence = B2 - Cambridge Advanced Certificate in English (CAE) or IELTS (International English Language Testing System) or completed high school education in English language.

### **Criteria for determining the order of applicants**

The order of applicants for enrollment in the first year is determined on the basis of the general success achieved in secondary education and the results achieved in the entrance exam.

The applicant for enrollment in the study program can achieve a maximum of 100 points based on general success in high school and on the basis of the result achieved at the entrance exams.

General success in high school is being calculated as the sum of the average marks in each grade of high school multiplied by two. On this basis, the applicant can obtain a minimum of 16 and a maximum of 40 points. Overall performance in high school is calculated to two decimal places.

The applicant can obtain from 0 to 60 points at the entrance exam.

Applicants who, in the third or fourth grade of high school, won one of the first three prizes in a national or international competition from the competition calendar of the Ministry of Education, in a subject taken in the entrance exam, may be awarded the maximum number of points in that subject at entrance exam.

### **Entrance exam**

Entrance exam consists of tests in Chemistry and Biology and an oral interview in English. Each test has 20 questions and each correct answer is scored by one point. The interview brings 0 to 20 points.

The right to enroll is granted to the applicant who scored at least 31 points on the entrance exam and is within the approved number of applicants for enrollment.

### **Registration procedure**

The applicants can apply for admission in the July and/or September enrollment periods.

When applying for the Call, an applicant-foreign citizen submits a notarized diploma of a four-year high school diploma, original documents from high school translated by a court interpreter appointed by the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Serbia and notarized by Agency for Qualifications of the Republic of Serbia, Majke Jevrosima 52, Belgrade, original birth certificate and translation certified by a court interpreter appointed by the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Serbia.

When applying for the Call, an applicant who is a citizen of the Republic of Serbia submits a medical certificate of capability for studies of medicine, which is issued at any Health Center or Student Polyclinic, Krunska 57, Belgrade.

When applying for the Call, an applicant - a foreign citizen submits a medical certificate of capability for studies of medicine, issued by a general practitioner from the country of which he/she is a citizen, or at any Health Center or the Student Polyclinic, Krunska 57, Belgrade.

An applicant - a citizen of the Republic of Serbia and a foreign citizen submits proof of the paid fee for taking the entrance exam in the amount of 140 euros, in dinars.

When enrolling, the applicant - a foreign citizen submits a certificate of regulated residence - MUP Belgrade - Department for Foreigners, Omladinskih brigada 1, Belgrade, proof of health insurance, Department of Foreign Insurance, Nemanjina 30. All applicants also submit proof of payment of the first installment of the tuition fee in the amount of 4,000.00 euros in dinars.

#### **Tuition fee:**

The tuition fee for studies in English is 8.000.00 euros and can be paid in 2 installments. in equal amounts of 4,000.00 euros in dinar equivalents.
