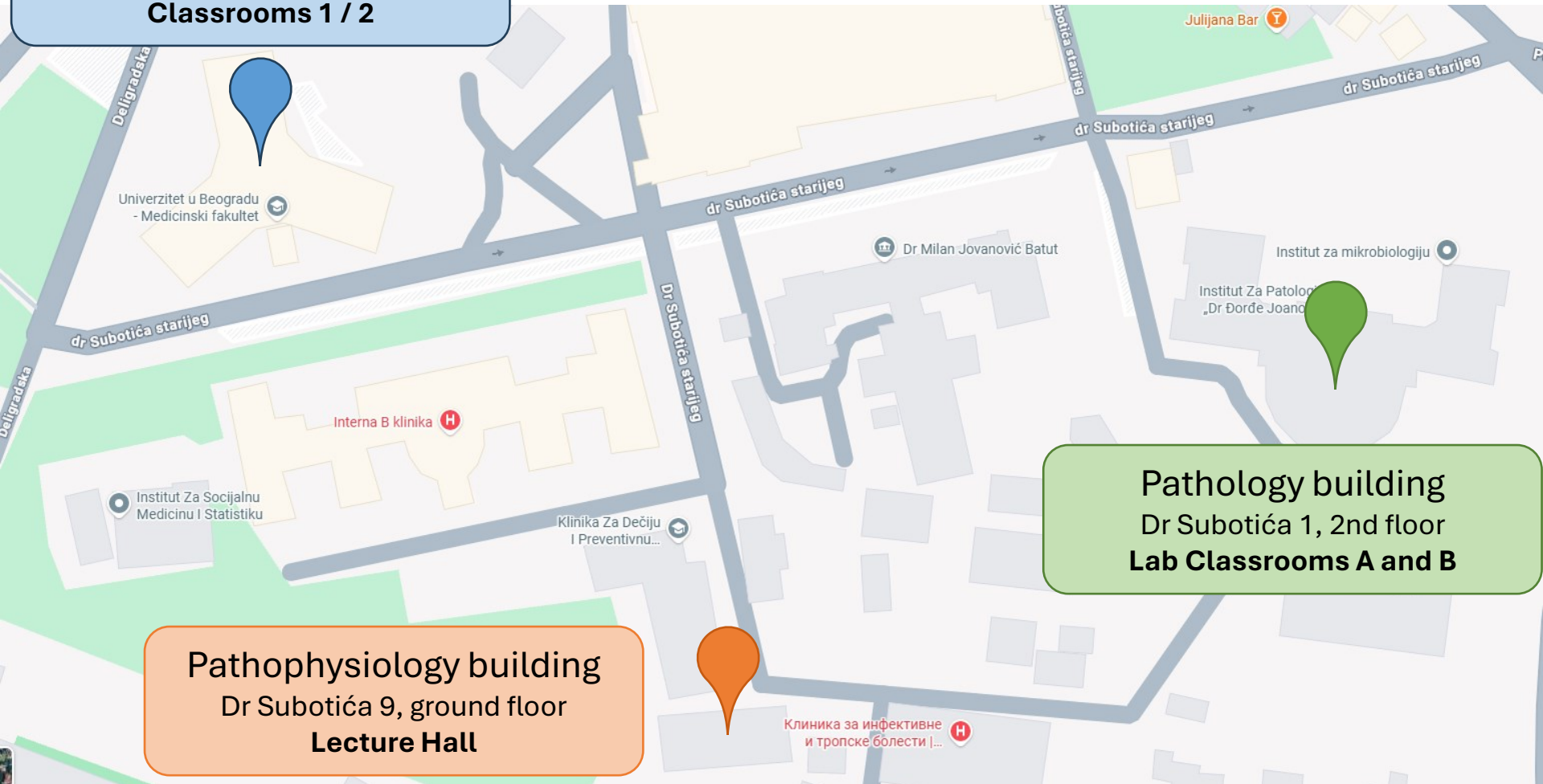
Classes schedule

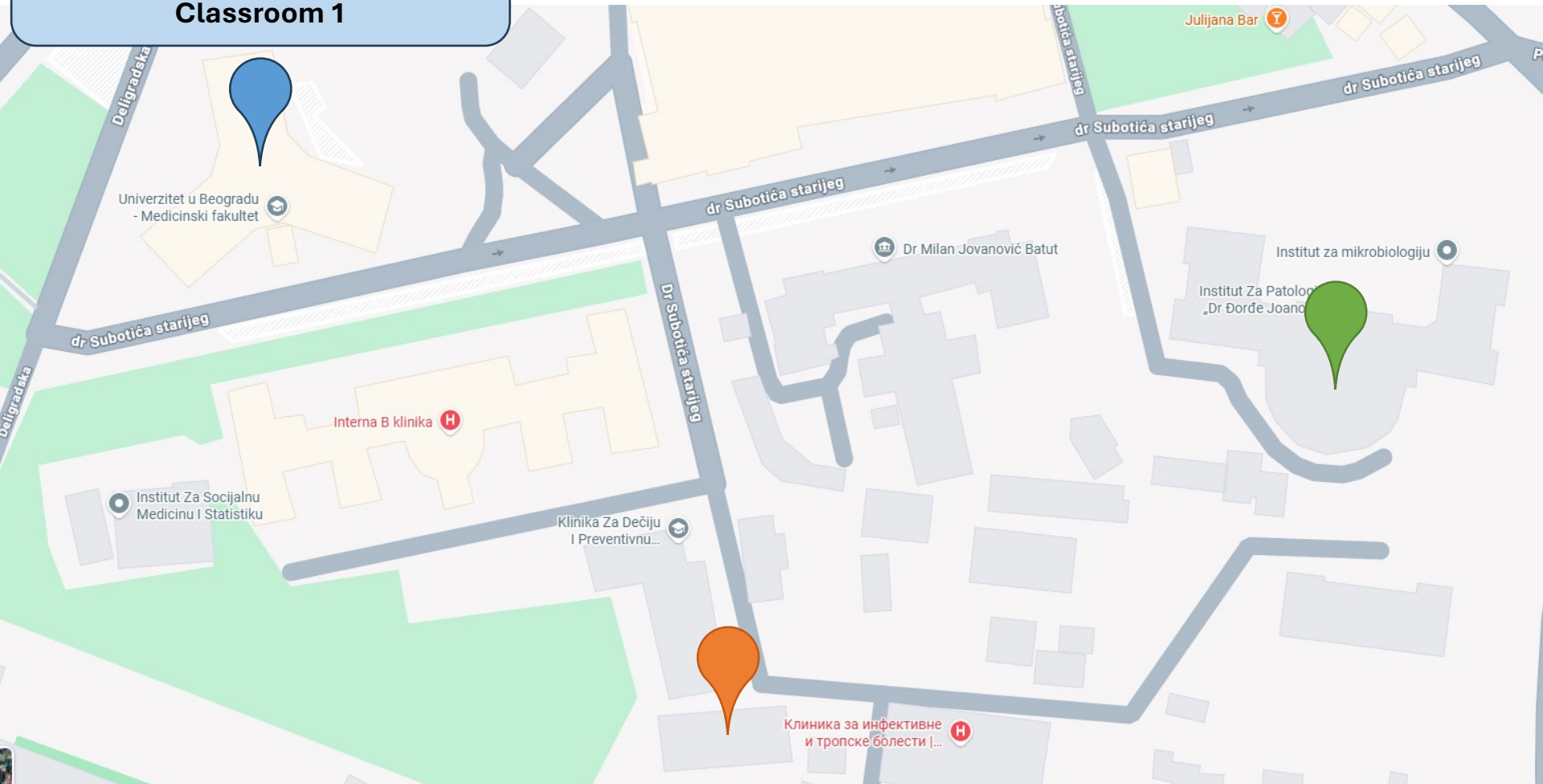

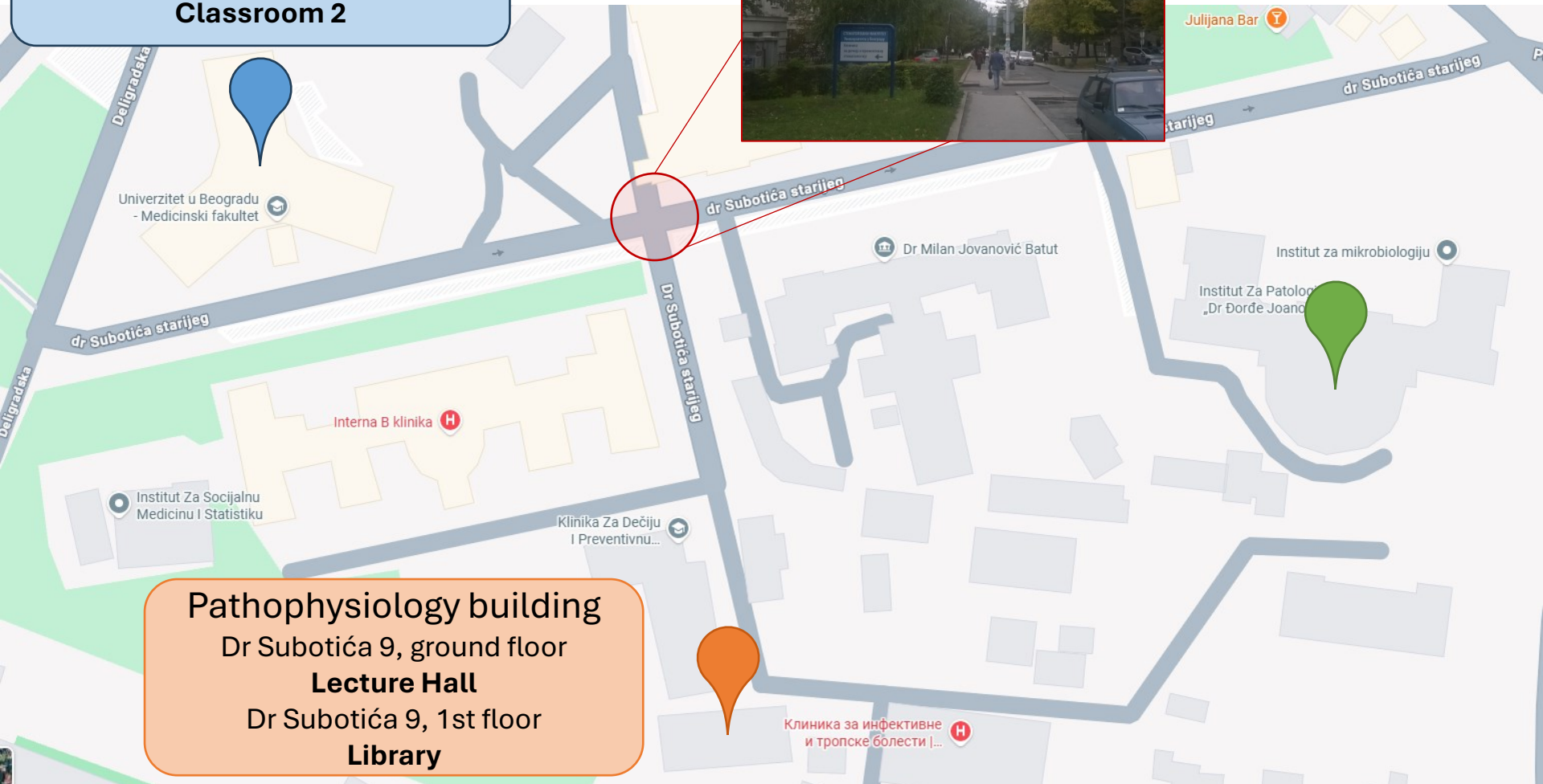
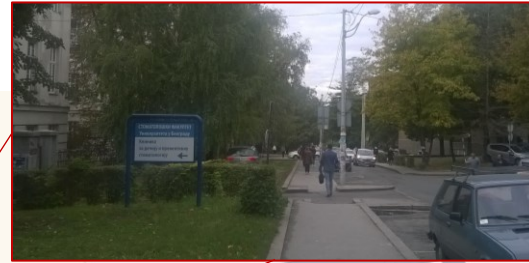

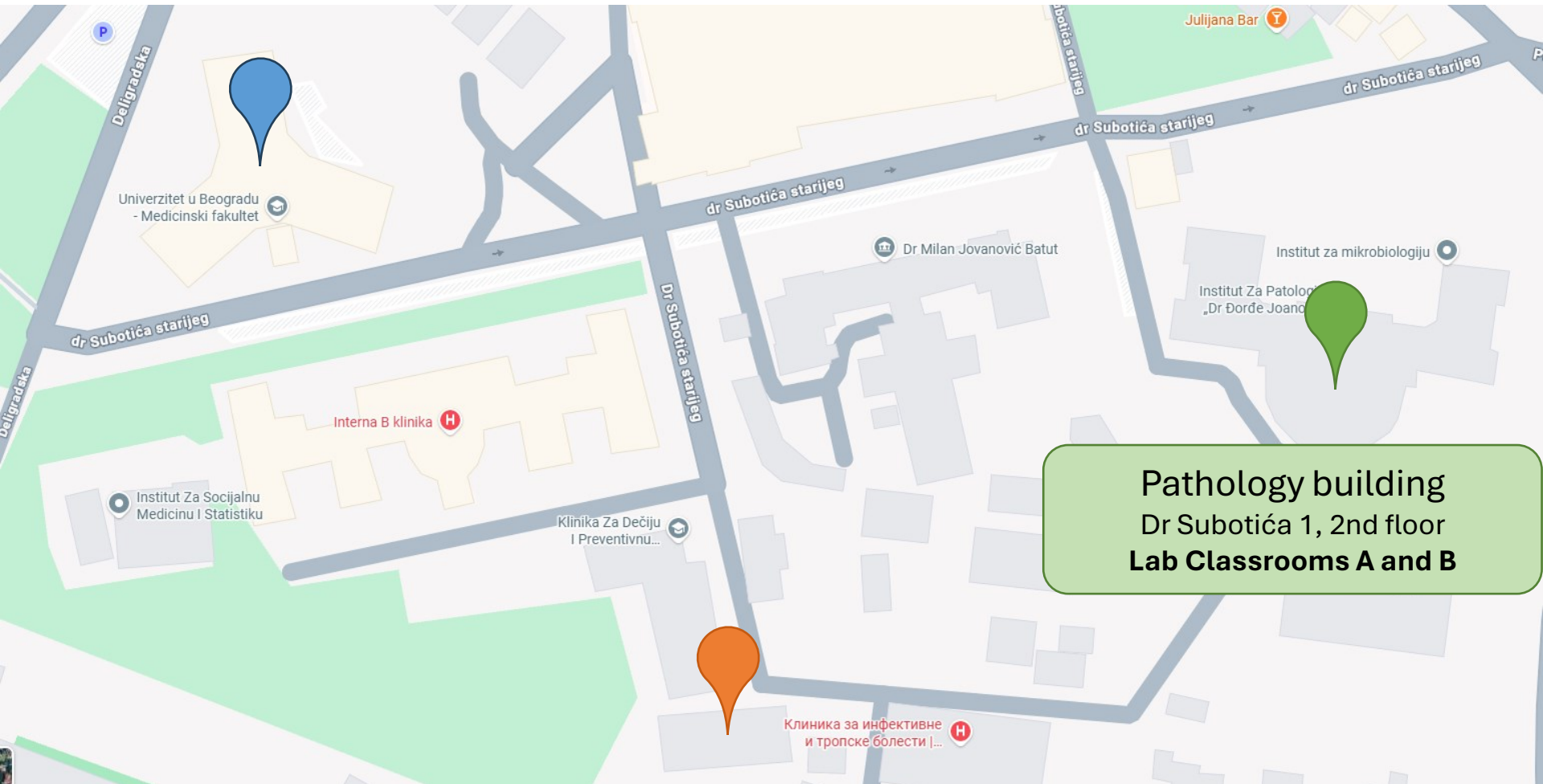
Lecture Hall door is to the left

- Study of specific aetiological factors, processes, and the ways they interact.
- Understanding of the genesis of pathological functional disorders, to the system or manifestations of the disease.
- Study of the ways a diseased organism adapts to the disease.
