

MEDICAL MICROBIOLOGY – GRADING POLICY
2025 / 2026
 (Effective beginning with the June 2026 examination period)

Starting point for Final Mark calculation:

- Activity during classes (10% of total grade)
- Colloquia (20% of total grade)

Pre-exam activities (30% of total grade)

- Practical exam (20% of total grade)
- Final test (50% of total grade)

Exam (70% of total grade)

Pre-exam activity (activity during classes + colloquia 1 & 2) up to 30 points (30% of total grade)

Maximal number of pre-exam points – 30
 Points are assigned as numbers rounded to one decimal place

 If a student misses more than 50% of the lectures during the semester, they will not earn attendance points.

Exam (Assessment of practical skills + Final test) – 70% of total grade

1. Practical exam in the form of a test (20% of total grade = from 11 to 20 points)

Total number of questions in Practical exam: 20

Number of questions according to Medical Microbiology course structure:

- Bacteriology – 10
- Virology – 5
- Parasitology & Mycology – 5

Type of questions:

- Multiple choice questions with ONE correct answer
- Multiple choice questions with TWO correct answers (indicated in the question)
- Fill (in) the gap / Fill (in) the line (sentence)

Minimal number of correct answers needed to pass the Practical exam: 11

The passed Practical exam remains valid during the current academic year (up to October 2026).

Only students who pass the Practical exam are allowed to take the Final test.

2. Final test (50% of total grade = from 26 to 50 points)

Total number of questions in Final test: 50 – each question carries 1 point.

Number of questions according to Medical Microbiology course structure:

- Bacteriology – 25
- Virology – 13
- Parasitology & Mycology – 12

Type of questions:

- Multiple choice questions with ONE correct answer
- Multiple choice questions with TWO correct answers (indicated in the question)
- Fill (in) the gap / Fill (in) the line (sentence)

Minimal number of correct answers needed to pass the Final test: 26

Minimal number of correct answers from each Microbiology section needed to pass the final test is:

- Bacteriology – 12
- Virology – 6
- Parasitology & Mycology – 6
- + 2 from any Microbiology part

Final Grade

The Final Grade is derived from overall grade points, calculated as the sum of the following:

1. Points from Pre-exam activities (0 - 30)
2. Points from Assessment of practical skills (11 - 20)
3. Points from Final test (26 - 50)
