## National Congress of Biomedical Science Serbia:

Already more than 60 years, Serbia hosts the National Congress of Biomedical Science, with the same being once and still today, one of the biggest of its kind in the region of Former Yugoslavia.

In this Congress, students have the opportunity to present orally the results of their research in all scopes related to Biomedical sciences that the student may follow in its "Faculty of origin", in our case MFUB.

According to a traditional rotation system, the organization of the Congress is delegated to a student organization of one of the Faculty members of the Association of Faculties of Biomedical Science in Serbia.

At the MFUB, for the organization and participation of its students (when the Faculty is not the organizer of the Congress) is in charged CSNIRS together with the Student Parliament (Serbian Studies) whose CSNIRS is a sub-section.

## FAQs:

- **Who organize the National Congress of Biomedical Science?**

*The organization of the Congress is delegated to a Faculty member of the Association of Faculties of Biomedical Science in Serbia According to a traditional rotation system.*

- **When and where are held the National Congress?**

*At the of April, beginning of May. Every Year is a different location, depending from what is decided by the Organizer.*

- **What are the pre-conditions to participate?**

*To receive the approval of the technical commission after the presentation of the Research Paper at the Mini-Symposium.*

- **How much does the participation to the National Congress cost?**

*The Organizer define the price of the participation while, usually, the Faculty cover the cost of participation, accommodation and transport.*

- **Does the co-author can present the research paper instead of the author?**

*Yes, it can. However, in the Records, the author would be mentioned first.*
